With time-of-day rates, also known as TOD rates, the price per kilowatt-hour is dependent on the time of day it is purchased. Price per kilowatt-hour is more expensive during peak hours. We want to pass the savings of purchasing electricity during off-peak hours on to you!

From 10 p.m. – 6 a.m. every day is considered off-peak. During this time, you will purchase energy at ¢6.639/kWh. On-peak is all other times and this rate is ¢14.914/kWh, this includes a distribution charge of ¢2.723/kWh.

This rate change is currently in effect.

This rate is intended to give members a financial advantage when they shift their power usage to low-demand or off-peak hours.
